- Convenience:** Ongoing guidance and support from our staff, with minimal paperwork.



## OJT Program Steps

1



Contact your nearest Missouri Job Center to confirm your eligibility.

2



Identify potential candidates who are: referred through a Job Center or are reverse-referred by you to a Job Center.

3



Develop, complete and sign the training agreement prior to the start date of the OJT employee.
